

Fireworks/Pyrotechnic/ Flame Effects Permit Requirements

- Company Information
- Active business registration
- Insurance to cover: venue, shooters, COA, etc..
- License Holder (Texas SFMO Issued)
- Federal explosives permit
- Primary Shooter ID
- Additional Shooter(s) License
- Event Schedule: Time/Date, Load-in, Shoot Times (demo/rehearsal), Event Duration
- Shot Types, Firing Systems, Equipment detail, Inventory list
- Site Plan to include:
 1. Event Floor Plan
 2. Effect legend
 3. Effect locations
 4. Fallout zones (Fallout zone for 1.3 pyro outdoor display is 100 foot per shell inch size)
 5. Distance from people
 6. Fire extinguisher locations
- Storage Location (In City Limits or Venue provide security measures and locations)
- Fire Watch Stand By required for flame effects and cold spark
- Arlington FD personnel and apparatus assigned to be determined by AHJ.
- MSDS need to available upon request
- Permits must be turned in no later than 10 business days prior to the event.
